The Liberty Township Roads/Services Department is preparing to keep hazardous road conditions as safe as possible for the travelling public during times of ice and snow. Please review the [winter weather tips](#) that residents can do to allow for safe, timely and effective removal of ice and snow from Township roadways. As a reminder, roadways are prioritized in the following order for snow removal:

1. Main roads ([see road maintenance responsibility list](#))
2. Main roads that need additional plowing
3. Intersections
4. Main arteries in subdivisions are given a quick "one pass"
5. All subdivision roads, excluding cul-de-sacs, are given a "double pass"
6. Main roads that need additional plowing
7. Any subdivision roads that may need additional plowing
8. Cul-de-sacs
