### Fun July 4th Festivities Set!

Liberty Township is ready to celebrate Independence Day on Tuesday, July 4! The annual 5K Run for Liberty will kick-off the day's events with registration at 7 a.m. and an 8 a.m. race start. The 3.1 mile course will start and finish at the Lakota East High School stadium and the top three males and females in each age division will receive an award. After the run, stay for more fun as the 32nd Annual Liberty Township [4th of July Parade](#) begins at 10 a.m.. The 2017 Grand Marshal is former Assistant Fire Chief Dan Bailey. Due to construction on Yankee Road, this year's parade will feature a [new route](#):

- Parade begins at Lakota East High School
- To Wyandot Lane
- To Stonehenge Boulevard
- To Stonerun Place
- To Woodstone Court
- Back down Wyandot Lane and returning to Lakota East High School

### Upcoming Road Construction Projects

A significant roadway improvement to Yankee Road is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, July 5. The road will be widened to add capacity and smooth traffic flow, thereby enhancing motorist safety. Yankee Road will be closed to thru traffic between Dutchland Parkway and Princeton Road. The project will involve [multiple phases](#) with various closures, so commuters will want to pay close attention. All work is scheduled for

completion by early next summer, weather permitting.

Another road projects kicking off in July will be [the intersection](#) of Kyles Station Road and Mauds Hughes Road. All four legs of the intersection will close for drainage and pavement improvements beginning, Monday, July 10 and will tentatively reopen the week of July 31.

## Recognize National Safety Month

June is National Safety Month and Liberty Township wants you and your family to stay safe. Here are some key safety tips provided by the Liberty Township Fire Department and the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission:

1. Windows: Install window guards or window stops to prevent falls.
2. Tipovers: Install anchors and brackets to anchor furniture and prevent tipovers.
3. Pools and Spas: Keep kids away from pool and spa drains; suction from a pool or spa drain can be powerful enough to trap a child or adult underwater.
4. Carbon Monoxide: Install a CO alarm and replace batteries every year.
5. Recalled products: Be aware of the latest safety recalls and get dangerous products out of the home.
