APPLICANT AGREES TO AND LIBERTY TOWNSHIP ACCEPTS THIS CONTRACT UNDER THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- May be placed in the right-of-way for purposes of loading or unloading for a period of time not to exceed seventy-two (72) hours within any thirty (30) day period.
- Shall not exceed eight (8) feet in width, nine (9) feet in height and twenty (20) feet in length.
- A maximum of two (2) Portable Storage Units may be permitted in the right-of-way per property; however, if the Portable Storage Units are smaller than specified above, more than two may be permitted if the cumulative size does not exceed the maximum size.
- Reflective tape shall be located on the ends/edges of the Portable Storage Unit.
- A minimum of three (3) cones shall be placed in the direction of vehicular travel to warn motorists.
- The Portable Storage Unit shall be placed on plywood or similar material to avoid damage to the public road.
- Any and all damage to a public road from the placement of the Portable Storage Unit shall be paid for by the applicant for this permit.
- The Portable Storage Unit shall be placed no further than ten (10) feet from the back of curb (or from the edge of pavement where no curb exists).
- The Portable Storage Unit shall not be located within thirty (30) feet of a stop sign.
- The Portable Storage Unit shall not be located within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant and shall not obstruct neighbor's driveways or mailboxes.
- In cases where more than one (1) Portable Storage Units are approved to be located within the public right-of-way to serve a single property, the Portable Storage Units shall be located on the same side of the road (if possible) or coordinated with the appropriate agencies to ensure they do not obstruct the use of the roadway by large vehicles.
- If a Portable Storage Unit is located in close proximity to another Portable Storage Unit, it shall be located on the same side of the road (if possible) or coordinate with the appropriate agencies to ensure they do not obstruct the use of the roadway by large vehicles.
- The Portable Storage Unit shall not be placed in a manner that impedes the flow of storm water.
