

Liberty Township Fire Department is committed to providing our residents and visitors to the Township updated information regarding changes within the Fire Department during the State and Federal COVID-19 National Emergency. **There will be no anticipated decrease in service nor delay in emergency responses.**



The CDC is recommending that if symptoms are present or you feel you may have the virus, but are stable, to contact your primary care facility prior to going to an emergency room or utilizing transport services. **Dial 911 for emergencies only.**

The changes and steps below were created at the recommendation of the CDC, Department of Health and the local emergency management agency.

1. Our personnel may be wearing additional personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gowns, Tyvek suits, masks and safety goggles. These precautions are for your protection as well as the staff.
2. Assessment of EMS patients will begin with a series of questions pertaining to the COVID-19 virus and will be conducted from the CDC recommended distance until additional PPE is applied.
3. Public education activities, station tours, CPR courses and car seat installations have been postponed indefinitely.
4. Life Safety and fire inspections are postponed unless it is deemed an immediate danger to life or safety.
5. No unauthorized visitors will be allowed in the firehouse living quarters, offices or meeting rooms to reduce the possibility of exposure.
6. Please follow all advice from the federal, state and local public health officials.
