The Township Planning & Zoning Department responds to nuisance complaints, including tall grass, weeds, garbage, refuse or other debris in yards, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87. Complaints may be made by filling out the [Resident Complaint Form](#). Liberty Township operates on a complaint-only basis.

Township Announces 2019 Paving Schedule

Road Construction Update: **Butler Warren Road** will close 0.1 miles south of Millikin Road and 0.2 miles north of Princeton Road for an intersection improvement beginning Monday, March 25. Butler Warren will remain open to Roberts Park Drive. The road is tentatively scheduled to reopen May 31. View [detour information](#).

State Route 129 will undergo a resurfacing and bridge repair project beginning on March 28. One lane of traffic will be closed during the resurfacing and pavement repair work, weeknights from 7:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m., with all lanes open to traffic during the day. View [project details](#).

Plan Review & System Testing Fees: As a reminder, the Liberty Township Fire Department will begin implementing plan review and system testing fees for commercial/multi-family new construction, additions and remodeling, as well as reviews of fire alarms, sprinklers, fire suppression systems, fireworks and more.
