Zoning Commission & Board of Zoning Appeals Vacancies

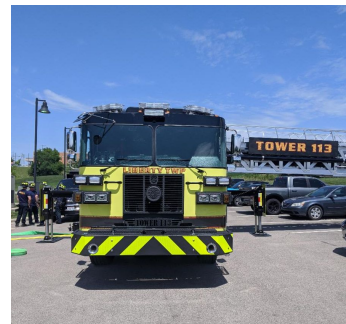

Fire Station 112 Update: Construction began on the Township's new Fire Station 112 in March. The station is being relocated from Yankee Road, built in 1974, to Princeton Road (across from Delhi Flower & Garden) to be better positioned for the community's future growth.
