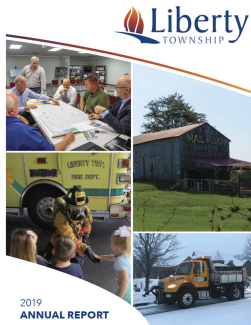

Construction is underway for the relocation of Liberty Township [Fire Station 112](#). The Township announced plans last year to move the original 1974 Yankee Road station to a new facility at 7655 Princeton Road. Construction is expected to be complete Spring 2021. Energy Aggregation Update

The electric aggregation program continues to move forward in Liberty Township. In November, voters approved measures to begin the certification process to start a community natural gas and electric aggregation programs. On April 21, Constellation New Energy was identified as the electric supplier. More information will be mailed to Liberty Township residents mid-May about the opt-out period. No action is required right now. The program administrator Energy Alliances notes that residents will be able to enter and exit the program at any time.
