Energy Aggregation Update

The electric aggregation program continues to move forward in Liberty Township. In November, voters approved measures to begin the certification process to start a community natural gas and electric aggregation program. On April 21, Constellation New Energy was identified as the electric supplier. Aggregation opt-out letters will be mailed to eligible residents and small businesses beginning May 26 with the opt-out period ending on June 16.
