News from the Fire Department

The Liberty Township Fire Department (LTFD) is happy to report the arrival of the new Tower 113 ladder truck. The new truck is the replacement for the engine that was damaged in an accident on I-75 in July 2019. Tower 113 reaches 100' high, weighs just over 80,000 pounds, seats five personnel and has just over 2000' of fire hose on it! The engine is also the first piece of fire apparatus with the LTFD's new paint scheme and striping package. Tower 113 will be housed at Fire Station 113 on Princeton-Glendale Road.



Open Burning Regulations

With the fall season quickly approaching, residents are reminded of the Township's opening burning regulations. Open burning is permitted within the Township as long as the location of the open burning is greater than 50 ft. from any structure and provisions are made to prevent fire from spreading within 50 ft. of any structure.
