2021 4th of July Parade: Apply Today!



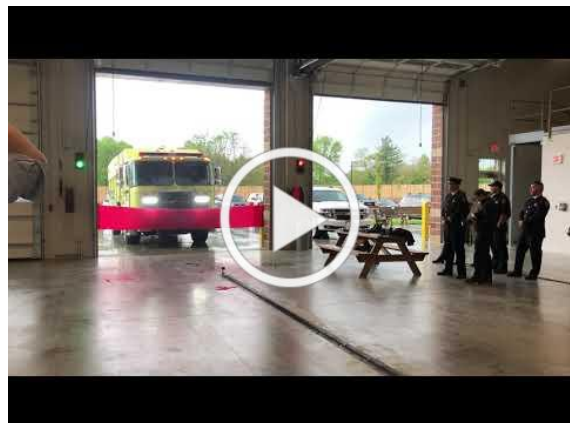

Liberty Township Opens Relocated Fire Station 112

Liberty Township Fire Station 112 officially opened its new location at 7655 Princeton Road last month. The new 15,760 SF fire station replaces the original State 112 which first opened in 1974 when the LTFD was a volunteer department serving a population of about 5,000. Road Construction Update

SR 129/Liberty Way/I-75 Interchange Modification: Construction began this month on a two-season project to reconfigure the interchange of SR129 at Liberty Way and I-75. The project involves the extension of SR 129 east to a roundabout at Cox Road, north of Liberty Way. The hope is that with the installation of the roundabout will provide a smoother and safer transition because it will eliminate crisscrossing of I-75 and Liberty Way traffic. The project is scheduled to be completed in November 2022. For more information, visit the [BCEO website](#).

Millikin Road & LeSourdsville West Chester Road Closure: The intersection of Millikin Road, LeSourdsville West Chester (south leg) and Pinckney Trail will close for a single-lane roundabout installation beginning Monday, May 24. The 12-week intersection improvement project will also include the installation of lighting and a storm sewer system. The new roundabout is tentatively scheduled to open on August 13.
