

Monthly Township Update January 2022

Millikin Way Interchange Update

Liberty Township, in partnership with the Butler County Transportation District (TID) and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), announced that the Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) is the preferred solution for the new interchange being planned at I-75 and Millikin Road. The selection moves a new interchange at I-75 and Millikin Road one step closer to reality. A target date for construction has not been set and funding for construction has not yet been secured. The interchange type decisions follows a significant public outreach effort, including a virtual open house, digital survey, and an open comment period, wherein a majority of respondents favored the DDI. The virtual open house provided a self-guided tour that walked visitors through the various improvement options under consideration and allowed the public to provide feedback along the way.
