### Spring Zoning Reminder

Spring is near and with springtime comes a natural increase in nuisance complaints. The Liberty Township Planning & Zoning Department responds to nuisance complaints, including tall grass, weeds, garbage, refuse or other debris in yards, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87. ### SR 129 at I-75/Liberty Way Nightly Ramp Closures

The Butler County Engineer's Office reports that nightly ramp closures between Liberty Way to northbound I-75 will begin on Monday, March 21 through Saturday, April 16. Crews will perform bridge beam erection and structure work, requiring the ramp's overnight closure from 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. for approximately three weeks. As part of the SR 129 at I-75/Liberty Way interchange modification project, various ramp and lane closures will be required during construction. Motorists are encouraged to check the [BCEO website](#) for possible date and status changes concerning this and other closures/advisories.
