The Liberty Township natural gas aggregation program will start this fall. Opt-out materials will be mailed to eligible residents and small businesses between August 26 - September 16

depending on your meter-reading-date. Only those on Duke Energy's Gas Cost Recovery Rate (GCR) will receive opt-out materials. If you are currently shopping with an alternate natural gas supplier, you are not considered eligible due to current Ohio laws and will not receive a letter.
