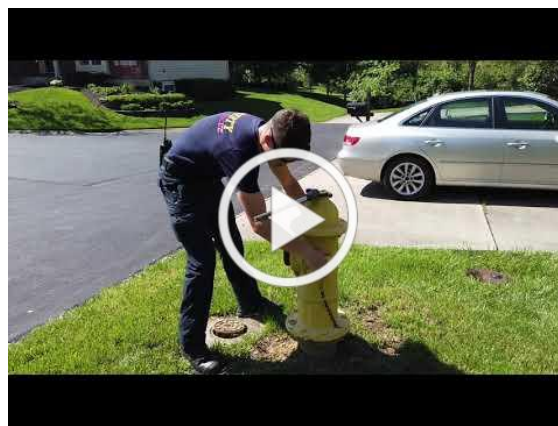
Coming Soon: 4th of July Parade Applications
