Spring Zoning Reminders

Spring is here and with springtime comes a natural increase in nuisance complaints. The Liberty Township Planning & Zoning Department responds to nuisance complaints, including tall grass, weeds, garbage, refuse or other yard debris in yards, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87. Complaints may be made by filing out the [Resident Complaint Form](#). Liberty Township operates on a complaint-only basis.

Message from the Liberty Township Fire Department

The Liberty Township Fire Department (LTFD) would like to remind residents of Ohio's open burn regulations:

Section 307 of the Ohio Fire Code:

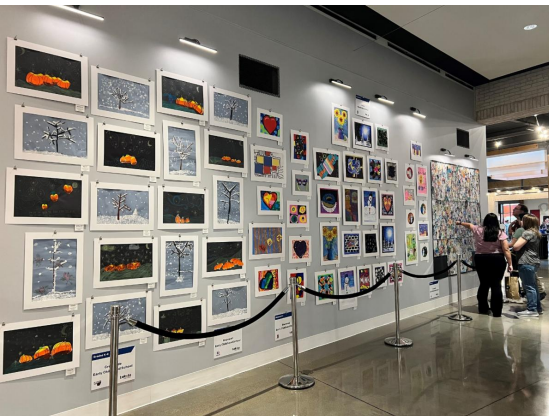
Ohio law prohibits outdoor open burning statewide in unincorporated areas during the months of March, April, May, October and November, between the hours of 6 a.m. - 6 p.m. The burning of yard waste, trash and debris, even in a proper burn barrel, is prohibited. The fire must always be attended. A method of extinguishment must be present.



No fire can be within 50 feet of a structure, unless in an approved container (chimney, solo stove, etc.) The pile cannot exceed 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height.
