Natural Gas Aggregation Update

The Township's current natural gas aggregation program with AEP Energy expires on the October 2025 bill. The Township has retained AEP Energy as the natural gas aggregation supplier at a rate of \$0.6499 per ccf starting with the November 2025 bill until the October

2026 bill. Those currently on the natural gas aggregation program or with Duke's default natural gas supply will receive an opt-out letter at the end of August. Those currently with a third-party supplier outside the aggregation program will not receive a letter. If you receive the letter and want to be in the program, you don't need to take action. If you receive a letter and do not want to participate in the program, follow the instructions on the letter to opt out.
