

# Station 112 Average Responses

Day Time (7AM-9PM): 73% ~ 2.14 Runs per Day

Night Time (9PM-7AM): 27% ~ 0.81 Runs per Day





#### Station 112 Building Facts

- Current Station 112
  - Built in 1974 to support volunteer fire department.
  - Addition added in 1999 to accommodate in-house part-time crew
  - Station was not built to house crews 24/7
  - Facilities are not capable of housing todays fire apparatus needs
  - Location does not allow sufficient coverage in the northern portion of Township
  - Location is close to our southern border, minimizing the coverage to our residents and businesses





## Station 112 Building Facts

- Proposed Station 112
  - New location allows us to better serve the northern portion of the Township
    - This improved coverage still allows us to maintain the excellent coverage we have in the southeastern portion of the Township
  - This station will house the same equipment the current location is operating
    - 1 Fire Engine, 1 Paramedic Transport unit, and 1 Water Tanker
  - Buffering will be between the facility and adjacent properties
  - Reviewing intersection controls to allow a safer/smoother transition through the major intersections
